And now, a word about SEATING!

We want you to be happy with your seats for the upcoming season, and will make every effort to seat you where you ask. Three things to note when making your request:

1) We've noted a huge increase in the number of requests for aisle seats in the past several years. We'll do our best to accommodate you, but hope you understand that these are a finite commodity and very few become available each season.

2) Member's seating is in the front half of the house, with subscriber's seating immediately behind. If you want a seat in the first thirteen rows, a membership is the way to go.

3) Seats are assigned in the following order:
• First, renewing members/subscribers who are retaining their seats.
• Second, renewing members/subscribers who wish to change their seats, with preference in the order in which the request is received.
• Third, new members/subscribers, with preference in the order in which the request is received.

The deadline to renew your membership/subscription is June 30. We will begin to seat the second and third categories after that date.

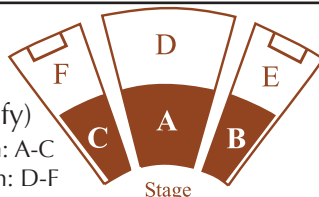
